

Grading Criteria

1. Google Classroom e-learning platform is used during classes. Each student is required to join the appropriate e-class using the account associated with the address assigned in the g.elearn.uz.zgora.pl domain. The relevant link to the classroom is available in the timetable.
2. Lists of tasks for the next class is published on the course website (in the domain of uz.zgora.pl). Everyone is obliged to know the topics listed in the section "Materials to be prepared" and to prepare solutions for tasks.
3. The solution of the selected task is presented by the student selected by the teacher (solution is presented on the board or on the computer of the teacher). After the presentation, teacher may introduce additional modifications to the task in order to verify the student's knowledge. Presentation is rated +/-.
4. In order to document the conducted classes, solutions to tasks from the list (Excel workbook or text document) should be attached to the appropriate project in Classroom in accordance with the deadline set for this project – it is necessary condition to pass the course. If solutions are saved in a single file, give it a name: **sol{nr}_lastname** (lastname = f(first name) & lastname), if solutions are saved in several files, suffix: **_1, _2** etc. should be attached.
5. During each class it is obligatory to know all the material already covered and material from the section "Materials to be prepared" from the current class. This knowledge can be checked in the form of a short, unannounced pass, realized in the form of individual tasks assigned to each student at the beginning of the class.
6. At the end of the course (at the last class meeting) there will be a final exam. Each student will have to write code to implement subprograms according to teacher description.
7. Each unexcused absence from classes reduces the final grade by **0.5**. Unexcused absence from the final test means a failed exam and consequently a failing course grade.
8. In the case of excused absence from the final exam, it should be passed on the date agreed with the teacher. Excused absences for classes missed during course duration do not excuse students from subjects covered by missed classes.
9. Only formal justifications (medical, employer, etc.) will be accepted, which must be delivered immediately in the form of a scan / photo to the teacher.
10. No grade can be corrected.
11. Any deviations from the above rules are possible only in exceptional cases and require prior agreement with the teacher.

Grades

The basis for the final grade will be the average calculated from two components: the average of the grades obtained from unannounced tests and the grade obtained from the final exam. The average obtained in this way will be increased or reduced on the basis of pros/cons obtained for the presentation of solutions (see point 3) – these pros/cons can increase or decrease the average by **0.5** (smaller number of pros / cons changes the rating in proportion to their number). Next, the average will be changed taking into account notes from points 2 and 6. Finally, the grade system will be applied as shown in the table below.
